Dear Patients:

I have been blessed to have had a 42- year career treating patients as an Otolaryngologist, TMJ specialist and sleep physician. I truly appreciate your confidence in letting me participate in your care over this time. There have been rumors that I am retiring and would like to clarify my future plans:

The Fayetteville location of Advanced ENT Physicians & Surgeons will be officially close by March 28, 2024. Since my practice consists of 3 separate and distinct entities, I have made the following arrangements:

1. Patients being treated for TMJ dysfunction may transfer their care to my Nurse Practitioner, Rhonda Museums, who will be working for Dr Michael Parker (315-468-6888); the practice is located at 5639 Genesee St. in Camillus. Rhonda has been working for me for 12 years and is well equipped to treat existing patients with TMJ problems. New patients with TMJ problems should contact the Fifth District Dental (315-434-9161) for a referral. Should you need Oral device therapy for TMJ, Josh Wolhandler, DDS can provide this service.
2. General ENT and Allergy patients would be encouraged to follow Rhonda at Dr Parkers office as well. Certainly, they are free to consult with any Otolaryngology or Allergy office in Central NY and we would provide records as requested.
3. The sleep medicine and sleep dentistry portion of my practice is much more challenging. I have trained a dentist Dr Josh Wolhandler (315-492-8138) who is located at 100 Intrepid Lane in Syracuse in Oral Appliance Therapy. Advanced ENT is moving its location to Dr Wolhandler's office and providing full sleep medicine services through this office, as we are maintaining our insurance contracts. Dr Sall will do all new consultations, follow-up consultations, and efficacy consultations via telemedicine through his website (www.syracuseadvancedent.com). HST's will all be dispensed at Dr Wolhandler's office and Dr Sall will interpret the studies. Patients who are candidates for Oral Appliance Therapy will have the digital impressions, insertions and adjustments by Dr Wolhandler and his staff. Authorizations, billing, and letters of medical necessity will be provided by Advanced ENT. My Office Manager, Sophia Nojaim, will continue to manage all aspects of the sleep practice in this new location.
4. Patients who are candidates for CPAP will be managed by Advanced ENT and referred to the appropriate DME provider, which is often insurance dependent, BetterNight, Lincare and local DME companies will all be used.
